



## Cookie Policy

### Cookies Policy - Art. 13 Privacy Code

#### Browser cookies:

Cookies are short pieces of data that a website stores in the user's browser during navigation. The use of cookies may involve the transmission of information between the website and browser, and between the browser and other private websites or websites that work for us in accordance to the Privacy Code.

It is possible to choose to be notified whenever cookies are sent or to disable all cookies by changing the browser settings. By disabling cookies however, some of our services may not work properly and it will not be possible to access some features served to enhance the browsing experience of the website. #### We inform you that our website uses the following cookies:

##### 1. Technical cookies

Technical cookies are essential for navigation and the use of certain features. Without them, the basic navigation services of the website cannot be provided. As explained in section 229 of 8th May 2014, of the Italian Data Privacy Protection Code ('Garante'), cookies "are not used for other purposes and are usually installed by the owner or operator of the website. They can be divided in browsing or session cookies, which guarantee the normal navigation and use of the website (allowing, for example, purchases or authentication to access restricted areas); analytics cookies, which are similar to technical cookies when used directly by the site manager to collect aggregate information on the number of users and how they visit the website; function cookies, which allow the user to browse according to a series of selected criteria (e.g.. language, products selected for purchase) in order to improve the services provided.

According to section 122, par. 1, of the Privacy Code, **the use of technical cookies does not require the user's consent.**

In this regard, 4/2012 (WP194) entitled "Exemption for the consent to the use of cookies", has made clear that the user's consent is not necessary when using the following cookies:

- 1) session cookies, when data is provided by the user for the duration of a session (session ID), or persistent cookies, limited to certain hours in some cases;
- 2) authentication cookies, used for the purposes of authenticated services for the duration of a session;
- 3) security cookies focused on users, used to detect abuses of authentication for a limited persistent duration;
- 4) session cookies for media players, such as cookies for flash readers for the duration of a session;
- 5) session cookies for load balancing for the duration of a session;
- 6) persistent cookies to customize the user's interface for the duration of a session (or so);
- 7) content sharing cookies through social plug-ins of third parties, for members of a social network who have logged in.

Some technical cookies used on this website are shown below:

- **abiogenPrivacy:** uses cookies to store the acceptance of the privacy conditions contained on the banner in each page.
- **Google Analytics cookies:** this website uses Google Analytics services to track the number of visits to each page.

#### **How to disable cookies through the browser**

Since the current provisions require that the user be informed of the procedure to delete or manage cookies, it is provided below.

Most internet browsers (e.g. Microsoft Windows Explorer, Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Apple Safari) are initially set to accept cookies automatically. You can change the settings of your browser, accept or reject cookies, or choose to receive a warning before accepting cookies from the websites you visit. Please note that by disabling cookies altogether in your browser it may not be able to use all of our interactive features. If you use multiple computers in different locations, it is necessary to test that each browser is set up to meet your preferences. You can also delete all cookies installed in the cookie folder of your browser.

Each browser has different procedures for managing the settings of cookies.
